



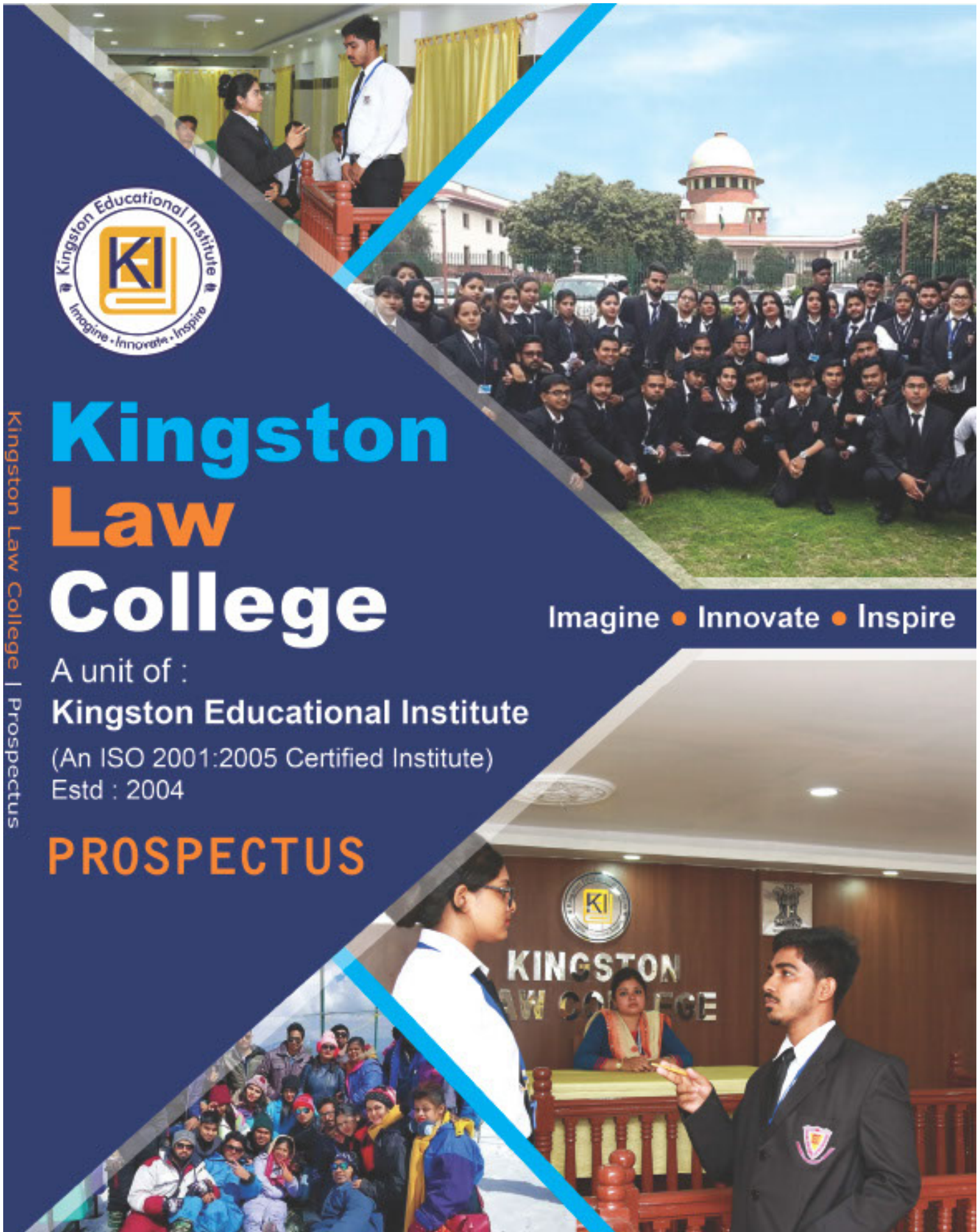





## B.A. LL.B. (H)

LLB is not only a degree for one to get an employment, but it is a way for them to deliver their responsibility towards the society. It also means a stand for and with the human rights. Since it is the base for our constitution and the most important tool for social reforms, a career in this field is considered as a prestigious and respected one in the country.

BALLB is an integrated course of five years duration. This is a professional course which combines Bachelor of Arts and Law. It covers various arts subjects like History, Economics, Political Science, etc along with the strong basis of law and legislature. The course is not only restricted to the class rooms studies, but it also includes the mock court trainings, case studies, etc.

The scope in law field is extremely diverse as there are different laws in force that need specialized legal knowledge. It results in ample opportunities for B.A.L.L.B. graduates in the industry. Public and private sector both require the services of law graduates. The law graduates can seek career opportunities in courts of law and agencies, state and central alike. This degree also makes the students eligible for appointment in UPSC, defense services and SPSC. Many companies accept law graduates as company secretaries. Other than that, they are also welcomed to work with legal consultancy firms. The law graduates may also opt for practicing law as a profession or work as a legal counsel or advisor. The law graduates with a penchant for writing can go for a career in legal writing as well.

## B.B.A. LL.B.

B.B.A. LL.B. or Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of Legislative Law is an undergraduate Administrative Law professional integrated course. It is the combination of the study of Law and Business Administration. The degree provides an integrated understanding of the interrelationship of Management studies and Law in their entirety than in specified areas. BBA LL.B. is a five-year integrated course. An aspirant will become a graduate in management as well as graduate in law after completing this course. Many companies hire those persons who complete this course. Some of the career prospects are: one can appear for civil and judicial services in his/her respective states, IAS services, JAGS, services in Army, Corporate Lawyer, Legal Advisors in MNCs and Company, Legal Processing outsourcing, Practice in Criminal, Civil or Income Tax as an advocate. There is much demand for LL.B graduates in Banking Sector also. In India various Banks appoint LL.B graduates for the post of Manager (Law), Legal Advisers etc. Moreover, Institute of Banking Personal Selection (IBPS) conducts CWE Specialist officer examination every year for various posts in the Banking Sector for LL.B graduates.

## LL.B (Duration- 3 Years)

The journey of Indian law schools from 'institutionalized mediocrity' (a term used by our former Prime Minister, Manmohan Singh) at a major conference on legal education some years back) to becoming centers of excellence in professional higher education has been fast. In just a decade or so, law has emerged as a sought after career. A student shall be eligible for admission into the semester 1 of the LL.B. (3 year) Degree Course in Law if he/she has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by State Legislature or an equivalent national Institute recognized as a deemed University or a foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalent provided that:

Such student must have obtained minimum 45% marks in the aggregate in the qualifying 3 year bachelor degree examinations; persons belonging to scheduled caste, scheduled tribe or other backward classes shall be eligible to apply if they secure at least 40 % marks in the said qualifying examination.

However, the college reserves the right to give preference in admission to those candidates who have secured 45% above marks in graduation or equivalent exam.

## Importance of studying of Sociology in Law

We ask the question can law as a social science be indifferent to a central social scientific discipline--Sociology? It can -- only at the cost of severe self blinding hardship. Society is rule bound while Law comes into being within sociality; they over-determine each other to the extent that it is nearly impossible to separate the two. Sociologists, teachers and practitioners of law therefore come together to form an interesting whole. Legal Sociology and the Sociology of law are such formations that have become increasingly relevant and mutually complimentary. From the question of 'how law can effect social change', the study of 'colleague relationships among lawyers', to the 'social and familial suffering of petitioners due to judicial delay' testify to the range and depth of issues involved. Students see for themselves that the bare, skeletal framework of rules and Acts become alive when Sociology is added into law, and thus Law besides being a social science becomes a human science by this single act.

## Importance of studying of Political Science in Law

The importance of studying Political Science in a Law course, given our own turbulent times, could hardly be overstated. From the international immigration laws, the Indian Supreme Court's judgment on Triple Talaq, judgment on Section 377 to other issues having a bearing on socio-religious ethos of the country — is it possible to think through all these issues without bringing together law and politics? Though the first legal-theoretical texts were scripted by classical political philosophers, later, politics would be used to critique the much vaunted neutrality of Law -- allegedly operating in a social





vacuum. Today, Political Science is used to understand, and convey, the complexity of Law. From the political legislature that enacts the laws, to the realm of judicial process where we explore, among others, the influence on judges while making decisions, to the courtroom culture --- the collaboration between political scientists and legal scholars and teachers has become imminent, so much that it is reflected in the increasing incorporation of political researchers and scholars within the Law schools and an integrated approach towards developing thought process. The formulation of a 'legal-political thought' and the investment of a newer curriculum not only informs the students of law of the political origins and ramifications of Law, but also the very true inter-disciplinary reality of Law.

## Importance of studying of Economics in Law

Law and economics also known as the economic analysis of law, differs from other forms of legal analysis in two main ways. First, the theoretical analysis focuses on efficiency. There are two distinct theories of legal efficiency, and law and economics scholars support arguments based on both. The positive theory of legal efficiency states that the common law is efficient; while the normative theory is that the law should be efficient. It is important that the two theories remain separate. Most economists accept both.

Law and economics stresses that markets are more efficient than courts. When possible, the legal system, according to the positive theory, will force a transaction into the market. When this is impossible, the legal system attempts to "mimic a market" and guess at what the parties would have desired if markets had been feasible. Law and economics shares with other branches of economics the assumption that individuals are rational and respond to incentives. When penalties for an action increase, people will undertake less of that action. Law and economics is more likely than other branches of legal analysis to use empirical or statistical methods to measure these responses to incentives.

## Importance of Studying of Management in Law

Management and law are two such fields, which when combined, will help one build a rewarding career.

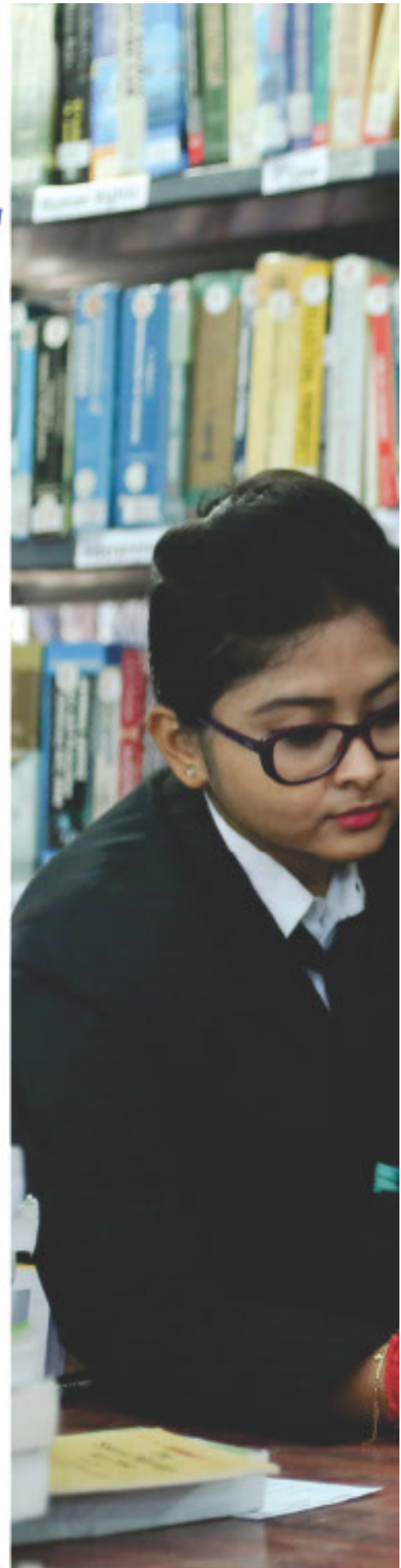
We need business laws/patent laws to cover all the activities so that businesses can operate with some measure of predictability. There would always be some risk that someone else would come along and claim the property and factory as their own.

Management field traditionally offers ample amount of job opportunities in the Private sector. On the other hand, a degree in Law course provides good amounts of Private as well as Government job opportunities.

It's also important for business owners, managers, and supervisors to understand what rights the business has against other businesses and individuals.

Most Corporate houses have a dedicated Legal team. The same is true for all other business activities as well. In other words, it's important to enter into a contract with means of enforcing the agreement.

With the right set of skills, one may land well-paying job and scale up career ladder pretty fast! Hence by combining law and Management, one is merging two very important skill sets!





## Importance of English in Law

English language has highest importance in law and legal profession. Firstly, we have inherited the present legal system from the British, who speak English. Secondly, our laws are drafted in English and then translated in regional language or in Hindi. Thirdly, the High Courts and the Supreme Court exclusively use English as the primary source of communication. Fourthly, in order to understand the reasons, objects, rationality and history of most of laws, one needs to look at English speaking countries. Finally, lawyers' success in their profession depends upon their ability to convince others about their point and the same is impossible without local, Hindi/English language depending upon the court. Drafting and presenting politically accurate words in a court of law is perhaps the most important attribute of any attorney. Most attorneys as young individuals possessed a unique natural talent to present themselves accurately and had the ability to literally talk themselves out of any issues, thus achieving success in their profession.



## Career Prospects of Studying Law

There are a plethora of opportunities for a law graduate. One can either practice as an advocate in a court of law or work with Corporate Firms. By clearing exams conducted by Public Service Commissions, a law graduate can become a Judge. After gaining experience, a law graduate can hope to become Solicitor General, a Public Prosecutor or offer services to government departments and ministries. One can also work as a legal adviser for various organizations. Teaching in colleges, working with NGOs and working as a reporter for newspapers and television channels are other attractive option. 

## Fashion Show @ KEI

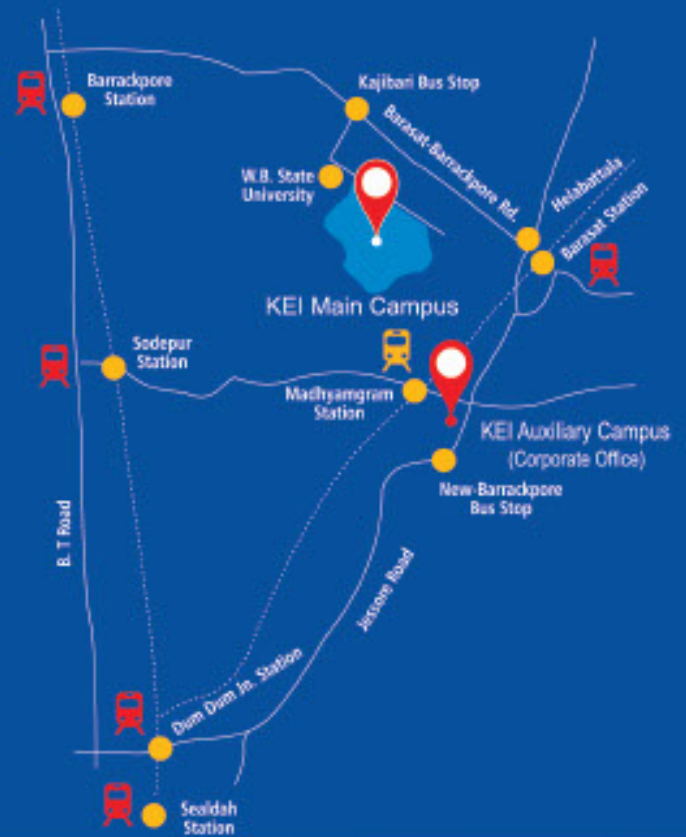
