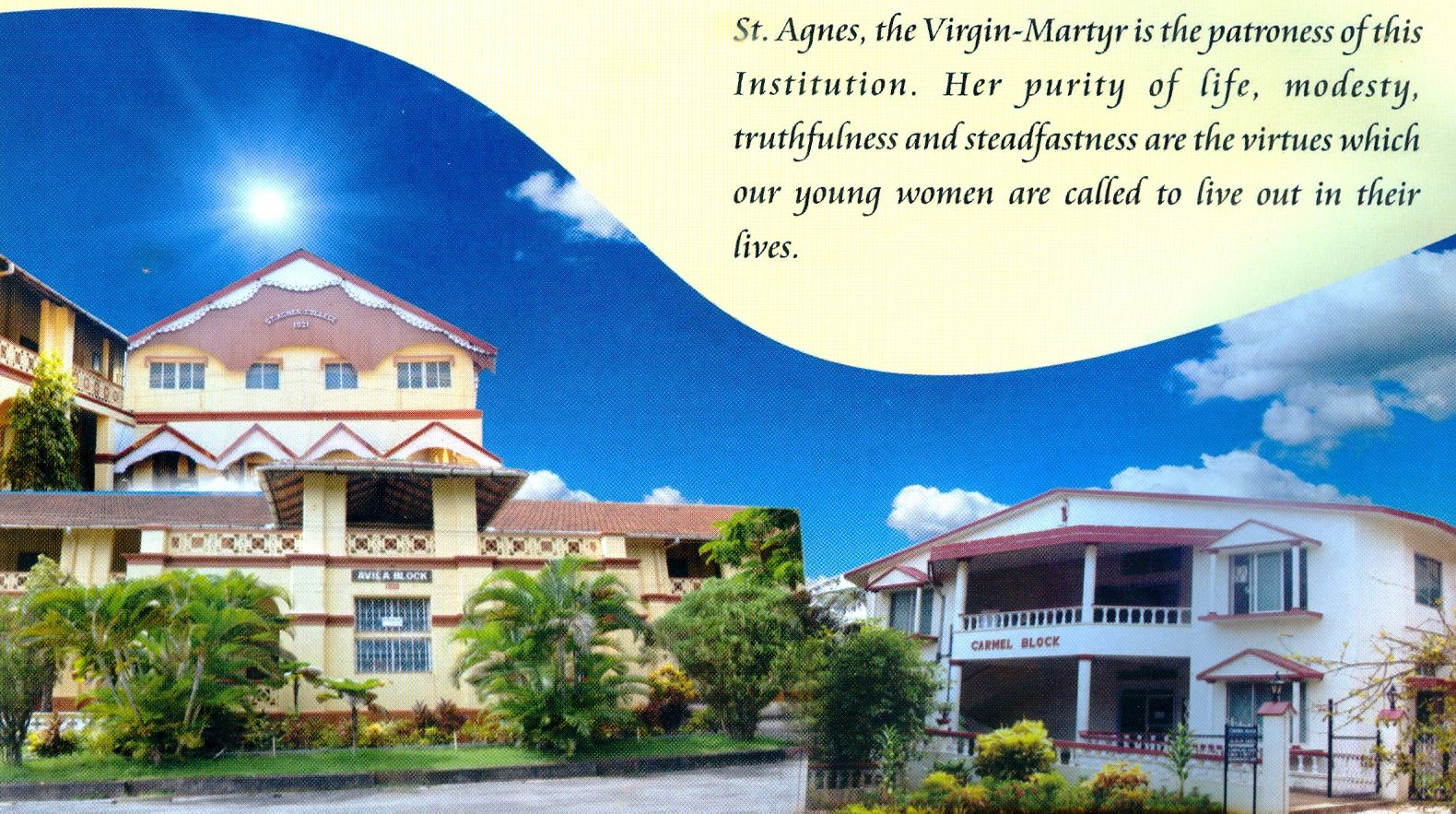
Our History

In the autonomous set up, the college is free to frame its own syllabi for the various courses and adopt suitable innovative methods of Teaching, Learning and Evaluation. With autonomy, the College has the liberty to teach job-oriented subjects and promote service-oriented activities as also to conduct examinations and announce results within the prescribed structures of the Semester pattern. The University of Mangalore confers the degree to the qualified candidates presented by the College.

The college is now all set to celebrate the Centenary of its existence in the year 2020-21. In the course of 97 years, St. Agnes College has achieved much. It was the first college in Mangalore University who took the initiative of submitting itself to the accreditation process by NAAC in 1999 and then subsequently in the years 2005, 2012 and 2017. In the fourth cycle, the college has been Re-accredited with A+ with a CGPA 3.65 out of 4. The college has been recognized as a 'College of Excellence' by the UGC in 2017 and conferred with 'Star Status' by DBT, Government of India, New Delhi. The College stands in the eighth position with a rating of AAAA+ (outstanding) in the list of the best colleges of Karnataka as rated by CAREERS 360 in 2016.

St. Agnes College offers Under-Graduate Programmes in Arts, Science, Commerce, Business Administration and Computer application and Post-Graduate and Research in English Literature, M. Sc. in Psychology, M. Sc. in Clinical Psychology, M.Com and M. Sc. in Chemistry. All curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are focused on providing students opportunities to enhance knowledge, acquire skills, nurture a culture of research and innovation and empower them to lead a wholistic and successful family and career life.

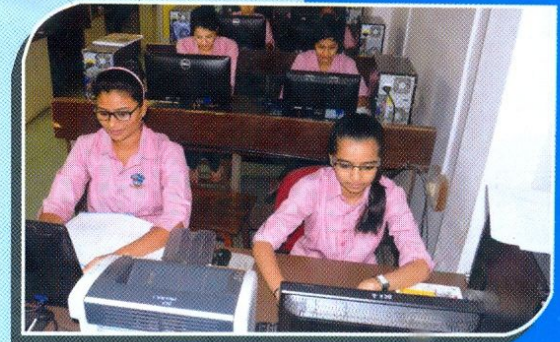
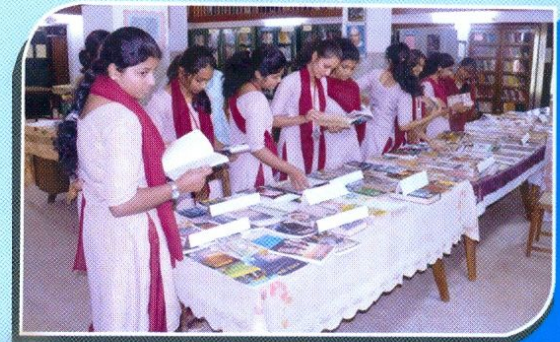

Equal Opportunity Cell : A forum to promote inclusive education and opportunities to all

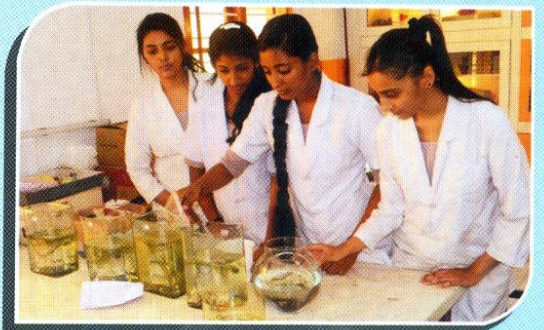
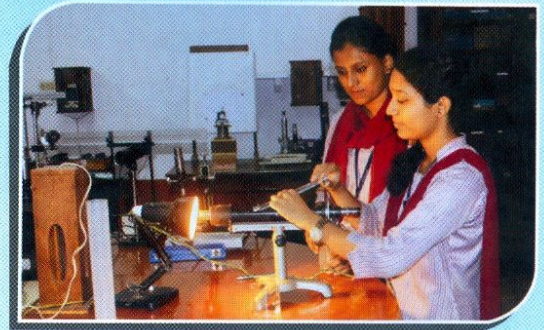

Admission Guidelines

- ▶ The Application form should be filled completely with PUC marks and then registered in the college office with Rs. 100/- along with one colour copy of SSLC Marks Card.
- ▶ Do not wait for the original PUC marks card. Kindly enclose the internet copy of PUC marks attested by the Principal of the concerned college.
- ▶ The registration fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ▶ Registration should be done immediately after the announcement of the PUC results by the Karnataka PU Board. Non Karnataka Students will also register at the same time with their II PUC Preparatory Exam Marks Card
- ▶ Spot admission for meritorious students will be done and fees will be paid immediately.
- ▶ Admitted candidates should pay the fees within the given time.
- ▶ The SC/ST students of Karnataka may avail of fee concession by submitting the caste and income certificate during the admission.
- ▶ The candidate must be accompanied by one of her parents for Admission. Please take note that a guardian can accompany the student only if both parents are deceased.
- ▶ The candidate along with parents/ guardians will attend the assemblies on a prescribed date.
- ▶ Parents who live abroad or too far from the college and cannot attend to official matters of the college are requested to appoint a local guardian to act on their behalf. The name of the local guardian must be recorded in the application form
- ▶ The fees, once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances

Autonomous System

The duration of UG programmes shall extend over six semesters

The UG programme offered is structured with 100 credits for the various subjects taken for study, for the award of the Degree. The credits are allotted to every course of study based on Marks.

Students are required to participate compulsorily in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the college as part of the credit based semester system.

Each semester shall consist of 14 weeks of study. The ODD semester will commence in June and the Even semester will commence in November

Assessment and Evaluation

The continuous internal assessment(CIA) will have a weightage of 20% and the end semester examination will have a weightage of 80%

It is mandatory to appear for all the components of the CIA.

Attendance

A candidate should have 80% attendance up to the end of the semester in each to qualify to answer the End Semester Examinations. Students who do not have required attendance will not be allowed to answer the examination. They have to repeat the semester.

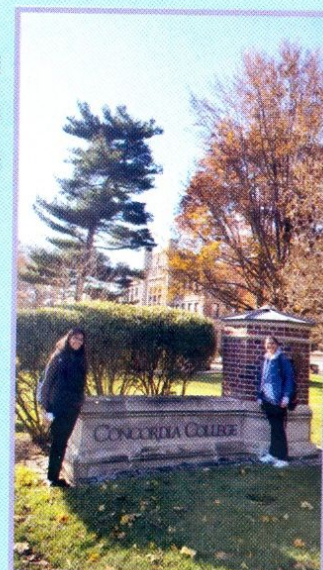

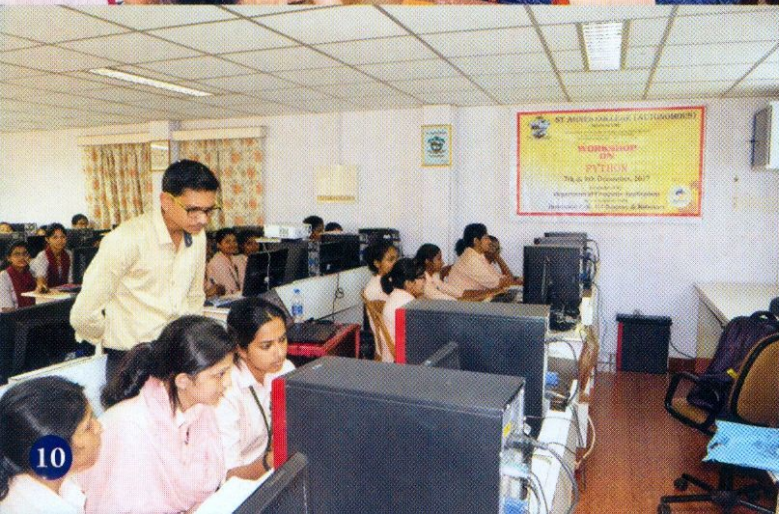
